

**Regeneration Outreach Community
Dress Code for the Kitchen**

COOKS SERVERS AND KITCHEN ASSISTANTS

- Hairnets must be worn on entering the kitchen; all hair must be fully covered by the hairnet.
- Proper hand washing procedures must be followed before any work in the kitchen. Hands must be washed regularly to prevent contamination. Contamination occurs when hands come in contact with face, hair, clothing or items not sterilized in the kitchen.
- All cooks and assistants must have short nails. Nail polish is not permitted. No jewelry, except for a wedding band, is permitted.
- Gloves must be worn if hands are cut, dry or damaged.
- Clean aprons must be worn at all times. Aprons must be removed when leaving the kitchen.
- For safety, all cooks and assistants must wear close-toed shoes; no sandals or open-toed shoes are permitted in the kitchen.
- Shirts with sleeves to the elbow must be worn at all times.
- Cooks and assistants must wear 3/4 length pants; shorts and skirts are not permitted.
- No eating is permitted in the kitchen when preparing food.
- Cooks and assistants who are sick or have flu-like symptoms are not permitted in the kitchen.
