In 2024 it was reported that homelessness in Peel had risen by 223% since 2021.¹

We rescued over **1.5 million lbs** of food and had **54,799** people visit the Marketplace

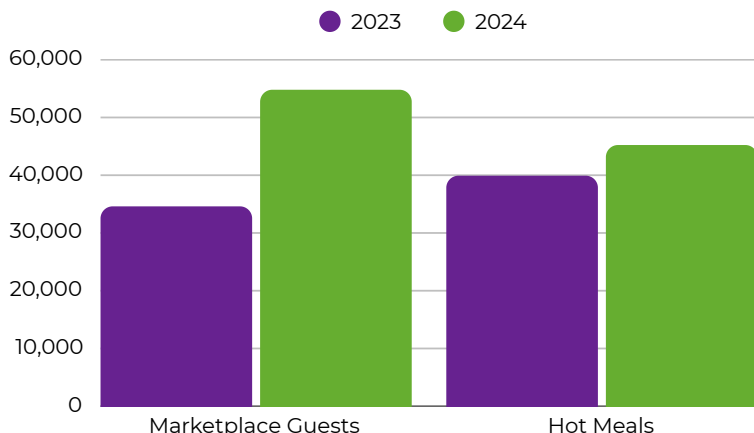
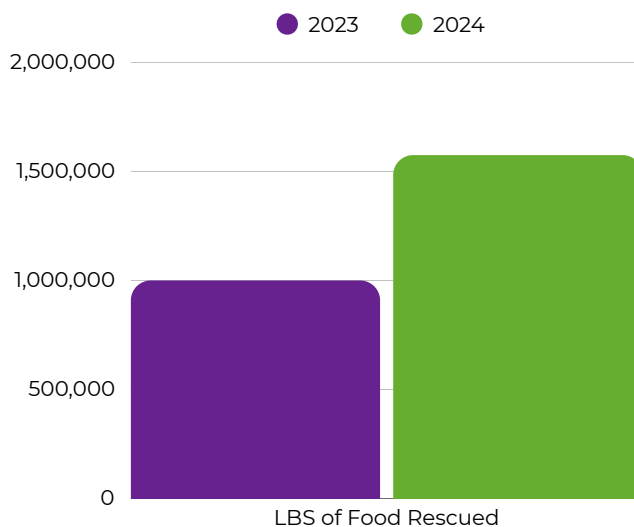
